As a Peer Minister serving in the Episcopal Diocese of Upper South Carolina, I understand that I am entering into a meaningful commitment of leadership, faith, and service. I acknowledge that this role is both a privilege and a responsibility, requiring dedication to my personal spiritual growth and to the well-being of the young adults I serve.

I understand that Peer Ministers work collaboratively with the Diocesan Director for Youth and Young Adult Formation, local clergy, and campus partners to support and nurture campus ministry. - Participating in periodic Peer Minister video chats, conference calls, and in-person meetings
- Practicing Safe Church guidelines and maintaining appropriate boundaries
- Working collaboratively with clergy, faculty/staff advisors, and peers
- Meeting regularly with ministry leaders for guidance, evaluation, and growth

I understand my responsibilities may include:

- Planning and leading campus ministry events such as worship, meals, and gatherings
- Promoting ministry opportunities to students through various forms of communication
- Serving as a peer pastoral presence for fellow students
- Participating in campus events to share information about ministry offerings
- Maintaining organized records and resources for future leadership

I also acknowledge the administrative and financial responsibilities associated with this role, including:

- Serving a term from June 1 through May 31
- Submitting required financial documentation (including a W-9)
- Managing ministry expenses responsibly and submitting reimbursement requests in a timely manner

I commit to offering my time, gifts, and energy faithfully, trusting that this ministry will not only impact others but also deepen my own faith.
